

would get a 2nd Place medallion. You are also required to provide all team members of all teams with an official Headquarters' approved Player Participation Pin.

If you host the Major Softball State Tournament, you are required to give the Championship team an official Headquarters' provided Banner/Pennant. The Championship team members would also each get a Jacket, Hat, or Sweatshirt with the words "Washington State Little League Champions," current year (jacket or sweatshirt were preferred), and a Champions medallion. The Second-place team members would get a 2nd Place medallion. You are also required to provide all team members of all teams with an official Headquarters' approved Player Participation Pin.

If you host any State Tournament other than Major Softball or Major Baseball (See above paragraphs), you are required to provide to the Champions a Headquarters' provided Banner/Pennant. You are also required to provide to the first and second place team players a medallion. You are also required to provide all team members of all teams with an official Headquarters' approved Player Participation Pin.

Each State Tournament Director will report on their hosted tournament at the fall Association meeting.

If a tournament host is not in compliance with the association's State Guidelines and in accordance with Little League Guidelines, the State Coordinator with concurrence of a majority of the Association members, may move a State Tournament if it is in the best interest of Little League.

SECTION 5 STATE ASSOCIATION SECRETARY

ELIGIBILITY - The State Association Secretary **shall be elected** *[proposed – appointed]* to a three (3) year term and *[proposed – approved by a majority of district administrators]* **current district staff member at time of election** *[proposed – eliminate this requirement]*. The Association elected its first State Secretary on November 16th, 2012, and he assumed this position on September 1st, 2013. All future State Secretary's shall be **elected** *[proposed – appointed]* at the September meeting. The following can cause a term to expire: **failure to maintain eligibility as a Regular Member** *[proposed – eliminate this requirement]* resignation, other event making it impossible to fulfill the term, or by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the Association members.

[Proposed - The State Association Secretary will:]

Be responsible for recording the activities of the Association and maintain appropriate files, mailing lists, and necessary records.

Maintain a list of all members and give notice of all meetings of the Association.

Keep the minutes of the meetings of the Association and cause them to be recorded in a file kept for that purpose.

Conduct all correspondence not otherwise specifically delegated in connection with said meeting and shall be responsible for carrying out all orders, votes, and resolutions not otherwise committed.

SECTION 6 STATE UMPIRE IN CHIEF COORDINATORS

ELIGIBILITY –State Umpire in Chief Coordinators – shall be current district staff members elected annually by the District Umpires in Chief at the State Meeting and confirmed by the Association. One umpire in chief shall be elected for baseball and one for softball. The Association elected its first State Umpire in Chief representing both baseball and softball on November 16th, 2012, and he assumed this position on September 1st, 2013. The Association approved dividing the position into baseball and softball. Both State Umpires in Chief were elected January 26, 2019, and assumed their positions immediately. All future State Umpires in Chief shall be elected at the September meeting. The following can cause a term to expire: failure to maintain eligibility as a district staff member, resignation, other event making it impossible to fulfill the term, or by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the Association members.

The State Umpires in Chief Coordinator will coordinate the state Umpire in Chief meeting, plan, lead discussion, and present information from the meeting to the District Administrators at the Fall and Spring State Association Meetings.

SECTION 7 STATE INFORMATION OFFICER

ELIGIBILITY - The term of office shall be a three (3) year term and a current district staff member at time of election. The Association elected its first State Information Officer on November 16th, 2012, and will assume this position on September 1st, 2013. All future State Information Officers shall be elected at

the September meeting. The following can cause a term to expire: **failure to maintain eligibility as a Regular Member**, *[Proposed – eliminate this section]*, resignation, other event making it impossible to fulfill the term, or by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the Association members.

The State Information Officer shall be responsible to maintain the State Web Site.
