



We are writing to inform you of an important update regarding the location of this year's Seniors State Baseball Tournament.

Please be advised that the tournament will now be held at the Ray Norton Baseball Field in Asotin, Washington.

This is a significant change, and we want to ensure that all districts are fully aware of the new venue.

The Ray Norton Baseball Field is a high school baseball facility with which the Asotin County Little League (ACLL) has a formal facility use agreement. Additionally, this field is included in ACLL's insurance policy, providing a safe and well-supported environment for all participants.

Please note that there is **no shade available at the field**, so we strongly encourage everyone to bring pop-up tents and any cooling devices you may need to stay comfortable throughout the tournament. Teams will be allowed to use drip lines, cooling fans for the dugouts, as well as coolers stocked with water and ice. We understand there have been concerns about heat, especially for those not acclimatized to the weather. Please be sure to bring sunscreen and stay well hydrated.

There will be concessions available on-site, and we will provide some form of shade to help cool you down during the event.

We believe this new location will offer excellent facilities and great experience for players, coaches, and families throughout the tournament.

2. Tournament Book & Roster Requirements

Tournament Book ("Tournament Affidavit")

Each Senior Division team must assemble a tournament book containing the following for **every player and coach**:

- Name and division of regular season teams
 - Birthdates for all players
- Number of games played by each player
- Approved waivers/exceptions (e.g., injuries, school participation)
 - Proof of residency or school attendance for each player

- List of coaches and manager (with completed background checks)
- Any additional documentation required by the district or local league

Note:

This book must be available at all tournament games and is used to verify players' eligibility and compliance with Little League rules.

Roster Requirements

- Teams may roster up to **16 players**
 - Players must be **league-age**
- All players must be **registered** with the local league and meet **residency or school enrollment requirements** by the start of tournament play

3. Game Format & Equipment

- **Game Format:** 7 innings; 10-run rule after 5 innings
- **Pitching Limits:** 95 pitches max/day; rest rules apply

Equipment

- **Bats:** USA Baseball or BBCOR certified only. No modifications (choke-knobs, choke-up assists, thumb protectors).
- **Helmets:** Must meet NOCSAE standard. Stickers/decals allowed if not excessive, offensive, or referencing drugs/alcohol.

4. Conduct & Field Rules

- **Ejections:** Unsportsmanlike behavior will result in ejection (per Little League Rulebook).
- **Electronic Devices:** One-way communication to catcher for pitch calling (defense only). No other communication allowed.
- **Prohibited on Field:** Alcohol, tobacco, pets (except service animals), outside food.
 - **Dugouts:** Only rostered players and coaches allowed.
- **Warm-Ups:** All warm-ups, including bullpen sessions, must be in designated areas.

5. Gameplay & Administration

- **Mandatory Play:** Removed for Senior League divisions as of 2025.

- **Pregame Equipment Inspection:** Umpires no longer required to check equipment; managers are responsible.
- **Roster Enforcement:** Only rostered players may play (exceptions to avoid forfeits under specific circumstances).
- **Rulebook Access:** 2025 Little League Rulebook available via the official Little League app.

6. Coaches Meeting & Game Day Logistics

- **Coaches Meeting:**
 - **Date & Time:** July 4, 6:00 PM
 - **Location:** At the field
- **Attendance:** Mandatory for all coaches
 - **Coin Flip:**
 - Occurs 1 hour before game start
 - Determines Home or Visitor status
 - Managers must be present and ready
 - **Game Day Procedures:**
 - **Check-in:** Arrive 30 minutes early
- **Plate Meetings:** 5 minutes before first pitch
 - **Weather Delays:**
- Updates will be communicated via email and text

7. Tie-Breaker Rule

For tied games, the **International Tie-Breaker** is used:

- Starting with the inning after a tied game, each half-inning begins with a runner on second base (the player who made the last out in the previous inning).

8. Pitch Count Compliance

After each game, **promptly have your pitch count signed off** to ensure timely and accurate record-keeping. This maintains compliance with Little League pitching limits and avoids delays or issues for the team.

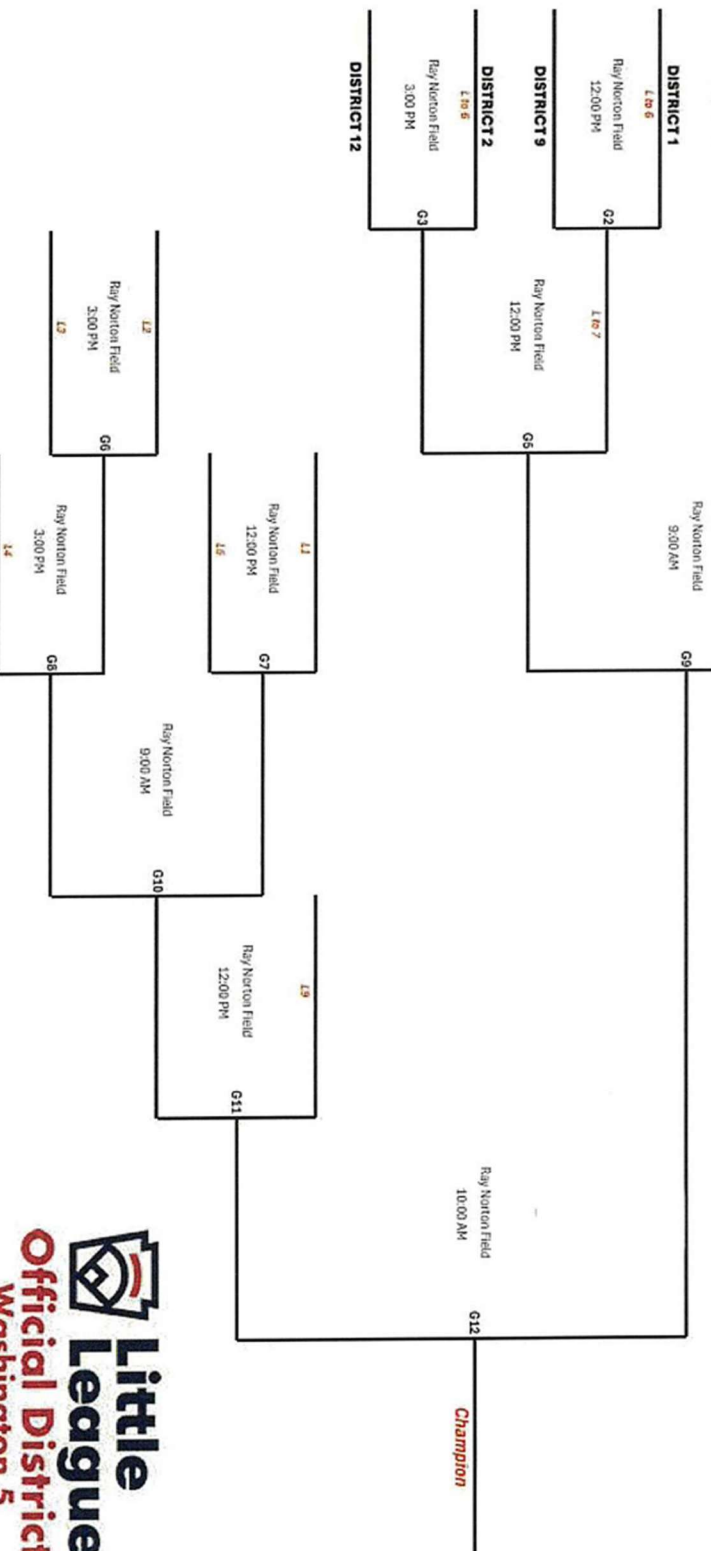
