Dear Little League DA's, Presidents, Managers and Coaches:

Congratulations on representing your District at the Washington State Senior Baseball Tournament! District 11 is proud to host this tournament alongside our host league, Anacortes Little League, at Daniels Field, 1309 G Ave, Anacortes, WA 98221 on beautiful Fidalgo Island. The following information will help your team benefit from all the planning surrounding this event, so please read carefully through this entire packet.

- Please email me your league name, the district you are representing, and your manager's name, phone number and email right away so I have someone to contact if anything changes or we need something from your team. My email is da.wa.dist11@gmail.com
- Also email me your team photo in .jpg format (we need the photo by Sunday July 5th to ensure your team's inclusion in the program) and your roster on the attached form. Please review spellings (check them with the players if needed). Once the program is printed, we can't correct any misspellings. Please note: there is a space on the roster where you need to provide us with the name of a parent who is TRAINED in keeping a scorebook, as well as a space for you to tell us the names of any parents on your team who would be willing to keep a pitch count, operate the scoreboard, or run the PA system.
- A mandatory meeting of all managers (coaches are welcome too!) will be held at 6:00 pm on Friday, July 10th in the upstairs room at Village Pizza in Anacortes (807 Commercial Ave). The room will be available starting at 5:30, so you're encouraged to arrive then, order some food and drinks, and be upstairs at ready to go at 6:00. Bring your binders with you as we will be collecting them. At the meeting we will go over game day procedures, facilities, rules and rules interpretations, practice fields, and other things that will improve your tournament experience. *Any teams not in attendance will lose their first coin flip.*
- Due to the fact that we are running the tournament on only one field, there will be no opening ceremony. However, we do have fun event planned for players/coaches on Saturday, July 11th after the first day of games conclude.
- Please see the bracket for game times. July weather in Anacortes is usually warm and sunny during the days (highs in the 70s) and a little cool in the evenings. We recommend parents bring a hoodie or blanket for evening games. That said, we do occasionally have a day of rain in the summer. If the rain is light/moderate, we will play as normal.

Tournament Notes

A mandatory meeting of all managers (coaches are welcome too!) will be held at 6:00 on Friday, July 10th in the upstairs room at Village Pizza in Anacortes (807 Commercial Ave). The room will be available starting at 5:30, so you're welcome to arrive then, order some food and drinks, and be upstairs at ready to go at 6:00.

1. Please bring your team binder with you. Make sure everything has been signed off by your parents, Player Agent, League President and DA before you leave for the tournament.
2. Documents inside the binder will be reviewed and returned to you prior to your first game.
3. We will return your affidavit and pitching records to you after each game.
4. We will go over the pronunciations of your team names with you before you leave the meeting. Please make sure you know how to pronounce all your players' names.
5. We will provide the line-up cards that will be used during the tournament. You will receive your first game's card at the manager's meeting.
6. We will conduct the coin tosses for home/visitor for the first day's games at the manager's meeting. The team on the top of the bracket will call the flip.
7. We will have district personnel (including umpires) to answer questions about tournament conduct, field specifics, and practice field availability. There will be an opportunity for you to ask questions about rule interpretations and common practices to ensure that we are all on the same page.
8. Please be advised that you are responsible to knowing the current year's Little League Baseball Rules and Regulations, including all tournament rules. Game scores will be recorded following each game on a banner at Daniels Field and will also be passed along to the Washington State Little League website director. The website is littleleaguewash.org
9. The field we will be using is the local high school turf field. NO METAL CLEATS ARE ALLOWED on the field, along with NO gum, and NO sunflower seeds. The dimensions are as follows: 325 feet to left field, 350 feet to center field and 315 feet to right field. The field has three sections of stadium seating, with metal bleachers above the dugouts. There are grassy areas by the first base and third base gates for those who want to bring their own seating or use pop-up tents. Pop-up tents may also be used over the stadium seats on the first base and third base sidelines so long as those using tents are courteous to other spectators in the area. No pop-up tents will be allowed in the center section of stadium seating. The facility has a covered picnic area, a concession stand, and restrooms. There is a small playground to one side of the complex.
