3. Tournament Book & Roster Requirements

Senior Division Little League Tournament Book & Roster Requirements

Tournament Book Requirements

The tournament book, often referred to as the "Tournament Affidavit," must include the following documentation for each player and coach on the Senior Division team:

The name and division of regular season teams for all players and coaches

Birthdates for all players

The number of games played for each player

Any approved waivers or exceptions (such as for injuries or school participation)

Proof of residency or school attendance for each player (to meet eligibility requirements)

A list of coaches and manager, with background checks completed

Any additional documentation required by the district or local league.

This book must be available at all tournament games and is used to verify player eligibility and compliance with Little League rules.

Roster Requirements

Senior Division teams may roster up to 16 players.

Players must be league-age 12 to 16 and have amateur status.

Players must be registered with the local league and meet residency or school enrollment requirements by the start of tournament play.

There is no minimum regular season game participation requirement for Senior Division players, unlike younger divisions. The roster must include all eligible players, and only those listed on the affidavit are permitted to participate in tournament games.

The manager and up to two assistant coaches (for a total of three adults) must be listed on the affidavit and are the only adults allowed in the dugout during games.

Additional Notes

The tournament book and roster must be reviewed and approved by the Tournament Director prior to the start of tournament play.

Any changes or additions to the roster (such as injury replacements) must be documented and approved according to Little League procedures.

The official Little League Rulebook (or app) and tournament rules must be accessible at each game site.

These requirements ensure that all teams and players are eligible and that the tournament is conducted fairly and in accordance with Little League International standards.

All teams must comply with Washington Little League and District 5 regulations.

Rosters must include:

Player names, ages, positions, and coach contact info.

Tournament Book must contain:

Medical release forms.

Proof of eligibility (residency/school enrollment).

Little League International compliance documents.

4. Field Location & Directions

Primary Address: 2799 6th Ave, Clarkston, WA 99403

Parking: On-site; follow signage for tournament parking.

5. Division & Tournament Rules

Eligibility: League age 13–16 (as of August 31, 2025).

Game Format:

7 innings, 10-run rule after 5 innings.

Pitching limits (95 max/day; rest rules apply).

Equipment:

Bats: USA Baseball or BBCOR certified.

Helmets: NOCSAE standard required.

Conduct: Ejections for unsportsmanlike behavior.

Full rules: 2025 Little League Rulebook (available via app).

6. Field Rules

Prohibited: Alcohol, tobacco, pets (except service animals), outside food.

Dugouts: Only rostered players/coaches allowed.

Warm-Ups: Use designated bullpens only.

Mercy Rule: 15 runs after 3 innings, 12 after 4, 8 after 5.

13. Volunteer Opportunities

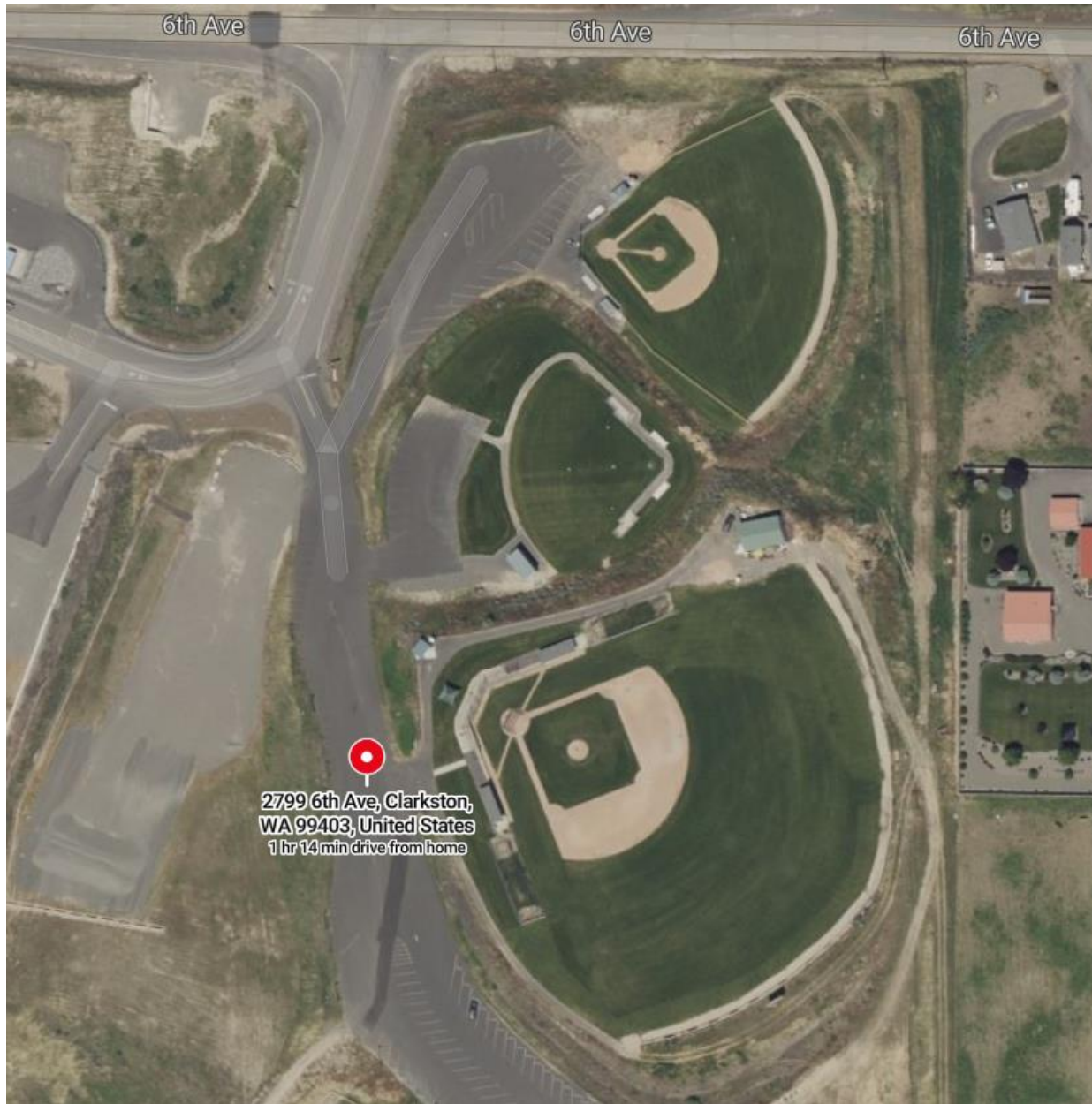
Help with scorekeeping, concessions, or field prep. Sign up at the Coaches Meeting.
